1. To enter and remain in this program, your cumulative, college grade-point average must meet the following guidelines:

2.00 GPA for 0-15 credit hours

2.20 GPA for 16-30 credit hours

2.50 GPA for 31-45 credit hours

2. Students may take these courses if eligible. Eligibility is determined by either ACT, COMPASS, or Accuplacer scores. Some students may be required to take developmental classes first. If required, these developmental courses will be in addition to the courses shown on the first page.

3. The number of hours needed assumes the successful completion of all courses in progress noted on this curriculum sheet.

4. Permission of the course instructor is required in order to schedule this class.

WHEN AND HOW TO APPLY FOR YOUR RPCC DEGREE
