CERTIFICATE OF GENERAL STUDIES

Description

The certificate of General Studies (CGS) curriculum provides a foundation in important skills in English, math, natural sciences, arts, humanities, and social/behavioral sciences. Upon completion of the certificate, students will be able to:

- communicate effectively
- solve problems
- think critically
- work cooperatively
- value learning

The CGS offers students who are undecided about career goals or unsure of preparation for collegiate studies the opportunity to increase readiness for collegiate study, explore career opportunities, and improve individual capacity for learning, personal growth, and interpersonal communication skills.

The CGS framework allows students who intend transfer to other two- or four-year institutions the opportunity to tailor their certificate courses to meet the admission or pre-requisite requirements of the receiving institution. The certificate may also appeal to students who, for work or personal reasons have to take a break from pursuing a degree program but intend to return to college. In addition, the CGS will indicate to current or potential employers that students have achieved important collegiate-level skills.
