- 4. Submit Accuplacer Next Generation or ACT Scores. If you need to take the Accuplacer Next Generation Test, visit the RPCC Testing Center.

TEST	SCORES MUST BE WITHIN THIS RANGE
Accuplacer Next Generation	225 or higher on Writing Test
ACT	15 or higher on English Test
