ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR PRACTICAL NURSE PROGRAM

Testing Requirements

Accuplacer Test (3 years old or less from program admittance date)

- a. Elementary Algebra- 52
- b. Reading-85
- c. Language (Sentence Skills) 86

OR

Accuplacer NEXT Test (3 years old or less from program admittance date)

- a. Quant Math- 245+
- b. Reading 255+
- c. Writing 250+

OR

ACT scores that are 3 years old or less from program admittance date:

- a. Math- 18
- b. Reading- 20
- c. Language/Writing- 18
- d. Science- 20 (In place of a college science)

Candidates should be advised they have 3 attempts at the ACCUPLACER and/or ACCUPLACER NEXT tests to achieve the required scores, with a minimum of 2 weeks in between each attempt. If they do not meet the scores after the 3rd attempt, then they must register in the applicable Developmental course. <u>Candidates MUST attain the acceptable placement scores in order to be considered.</u> The ACCUPLACER and/or ACCUPLACER NEXT test may be scheduled with RPCC's Student Services.

PREREQUISITES PRACTICAL NURSE

ALL DEVELOPMENTAL REQUIREMENTS MUST BE SATISFIED BEFORE SCHEDULING ANY CLASSES.

COURSE	Example
College Science (less than 7 years old)	College Biology, Chemistry, Microbiology, or A & P
Computer Literacy (less than 7 years old)	CSCI 1010 or high school credit
Medical Terminology	HESC 1000

Additional Requirements

- 1. Candidates should have a high school diploma or equivalent GED.
- 2. Candidates should be advised that having all prerequisites does not guarantee acceptance into the program.
- 3. Candidates are advised that they will have to pass a background check, drug screen, physical, and undergo an interview with the nursing faculty.
- 4. Submit a RPCC Practical Nursing application.
- 5. Submit immunization records, valid State Issued driver's license or ID, birth certificate, and social security card.
