ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Completed RPCC admission application
2. Submit High School and/or previous college transcripts
3. Complete Background Check ("Right to Review")
4. Successful scores on the ACCUPLACER/ACCUPLACER NEXT or ACT Test or complete developmental courses before completion of program.
 - a) Must be three (3) years old or less from program admittance date
 - b) Scores per RPCC admittance requirements
 - c) In place of the ACCUPLACER/ACCUPLACER NEXT test we will accept the following ACT scores that are three (3) years old or less from program admittance date:
 - Math – 19
 - Reading – 16
 - English – 18
5. Submit a RPCC Patient Care Technician application.
6. Submit immunization records, valid State Issued driver's license or ID, birth certificate, and social security card.
